NOTICE: Call for Concept Notes for Community-Based Research Grants 2023

The Centre for Research and Innovation (CRI) under Prithvi Narayan Campus invites **concept notes** from eligible faculty members (full time faculty with PhD as Principal Researcher; other 4 members including full or part time faculty, any one faculty for inclusive representation and any one from the relevant field outside the campus) for the “**Community-Based Research Grants 2023**” award. For this year, one grant will be made available for research in the areas of humanities & social sciences, management, education, law and sciences, which should be completed within a period of one year. A sum of Rs. 3,00,000.00 (three lakh rupees) will be granted as a research funding for the project. For detailed information, please see the application guidelines attached herewith.

Award Release Date: 25 March 2023

Community-Based Research Grants 2023
APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The Centre for Research and Innovation under Prithvi Narayan Campus invites concept notes along with duly filled-in application forms from eligible faculty members for the “Community-Based Research Grants 2023” award. The applicants should meet the following criteria to be eligible for the competition:

Minimum Requirements for Eligibility

Faculty members who fulfill the following requirements may apply for awards:

- 1) The research grant can be awarded to a group of researchers belonging to the area of humanities & social sciences, management, education, law and sciences.
- 2) The researcher/s must be a full time faculty with PhD as Principal Researcher. The research group should consist of 5 members in total from the relevant topic: full or part time faculty members and at least one member for inclusive representation and one member from the relevant field outside the campus).
- 3) Applicants must be less than 60 years of age to be eligible for grants.
- 4) The CRI members and any other Selection Committee members under the CRI are not eligible to apply.
- 5) Applicants who have currently received fellowships/research grants from the UGC or TU are not eligible to apply.
- 6) Applicants who have on any type of leave from Tribhuvan University will not be eligible for the awards.
- 7) Applicants who have received any research grants from the **CRI** under Prithvi Narayan Campus over the last two consecutive cycles will not be considered for the awards.
- 8) If the researcher/s agree that they are ready to give the copyright of the research report to the CRI and to publish an article based on the funded research report in the *Prithvi Journal of Research and Innovation*.
- 9) In case of dispute, the final decision will be made by the Selection Committee under the CRI of Prithvi Narayan Campus.

Documents to be submitted for awards

In order to apply for the awards, the applicants should prepare the application package of the following 4 documents (filled-in application form and concept note; CVs of all members in a single file; and bank voucher).

- 1) An application form must be submitted in the specified format available from the CRI or on the Prithvi Narayan Campus website <www.pncampus.edu.np>.

- 2) A concept note in APA format. The length of the proposal should not exceed 2-3 pages including the cover page with single line spacing throughout the note. Please be advised that the researchers have to submit the detailed project proposal after the selection of the best research group through the first round of competition (that is, through concept notes). Two best concept notes will be notified to submit the detailed project proposal (including the deadline for submission and about how to develop the project proposal)
- 3) CVs of all members of the research group. Each CV should not exceed 3 pages.
- 4) A voucher of Rs. 500 (five hundred rupees only) paid to Prithvi Narayan Campus as application processing charge deposited in the bank:
