Dr Suresh Raj Sharma



Dr. Suresh Raj Sharma is the founder Vice-Chancellor of Kathmandu University, Nepal. He served as Professor of Chemistry for Tribhuvan University for a long time. He was the first Executive Director of the Council for Technical Education and Vocational Training (CTEVT) in Nepal. He has also worked as Member Secretary of National Education Committee, a member of National Commission for UNESCO and a delegate to the SAARC Technical Committee on Science and Technology.

Currently, Dr. Sharma is a member of the Board of Trustee of Kathmandu University and the Coordinator of Kathmandu University School of Law Planning Advisory Committee. He received his Ph.D. in Chemistry from London South Bank University, UK.

Dr. Sharma's paramount contribution to education in Nepal was the establishment of Kathmandu University as a public university in 1991 and his commitment to global engagement in higher education.

Dr. Tom Robertson



Dr. Tom Robertson is the former Executive Director of the United States Fulbright Commission to Nepal. He is an environmental historian who has published widely on topics related to Nepal's development programs and environmental issues.

Dr. Robertson did his Ph.D. in environmental history from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and was Professor of History at Worcester Polytechnic Institutein Massachusetts.

Dr. Vikash Kumar KC is Professor of Statistics at Prithvi Narayan Campus, Tribhuvan University, Pokhara, Nepal. He received his M.Phil. in 2004 and Ph.D. in 2008 from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, India. The conference provides an international platform for the presentations of current and futures directions in research, theory and practice on topics related to humanities & social sciences, management & law, education, and science & technology.

We accept abstract submissions for full papers followed by oral, poster and virtual presentations at the conference. You can join this conference as a presenter, or an audience. We look forward to hearing from you.

All full paper submissions will be peer reviewed and evaluated based on originality, technical and/or research depth, accuracy and relevance to conference theme and topics. Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee. If the abstract is accepted, the authors have to submit their full papers and presentation materials. All submissions should be original and unpublished research results and will be accepted via Online Submission. All manuscripts should meet the format specified by the Scientific Committee and will be peer reviewed and evaluated based on originality, research depth, technical accuracy and relevance to the conference theme and topics.

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

Abstract Guidelines

You can send your abstract for evaluation by the conference team. If your abstract is accepted, you will be asked to provide us the full paper for publication in one of our academic journals and PowerPoint presentation slides for oral presentation, poster presentation and virtual presentation at the conference. All accepted abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings.

You are invited to submit your abstract, following the format specified by the conference team. Your abstract must include the title of the paper, your name with designation, affiliation, address, telephone number, and email address. You should also need to include a short biography of 100 words. Your abstract should be written and limited to 300 to 500 words, followed by 3 to 5 keywords.

Full Paper Guidelines

After your abstract is selected, we accept the full paper of high-quality, original and unpublished results of research in the entire topic areas. All paper submissions are expected to meet the following requirements:

- All submissions must be written in English and must follow the layout format of either MLA or APA style.
- The manuscripts should not exceed 7000 words and be at least 3000 words including tables and charts and be with 3 to 5 keywords.
- The authors should use 12-point Times New Roman font with single spaced and 5-space indented paragraphs.
- All manuscripts will pass through a double blind peer-review and are expected to meet the scientific criteria of novelty and academic excellence.

- Manuscripts submitted to the conference should be original unpublished results. If any paper is found to be plagiarized, the submission will be automatically rejected.
- If the paper is co-authored, it is the responsibility of the corresponding author to ensure the co-author/s' consent to submit for publication and during submission and peer review process.
- All manuscripts should have the following components:
 - 1) Introduction: Purpose/Objectives
 - 2) Methodology/Approach
 - 3) Findings/Results
 - 4) Conclusions/Implications
 - 5) Recommendations (where appropriate)
 - 6) Acknowledgements (where appropriate)
 - 7) References
 - 8) Appendices (where appropriate)
- All submissions should be sent to the conference team via Online Submission portal.
- The concerned author/s will legally be held responsible for all views and information presented in the accepted papers if any claims made by the third parties.

Oral Presentation Guidelines

The length of the oral presentation will be around 15 minutes. You can use any form of oral presentations you wish, the conference team will provide you with the necessary equipments upon request. All presenters should make sure that you need to present at the conference venue at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled time for presentation.

Poster Presentation Guidelines

You can also send your abstracts for poster presentations. If your abstract and full paper are accepted, you will be expected to prepare a poster display of your paper for presentation at the conference. The poster should be self-explanatory, but the author should be available at certain times, such as refreshment breaks and during the time devoted to poster session, to interact with viewers and answer questions. A total of 15 minutes' time will be provided for each poster presentation.

Virtual Presentation Guidelines

If you cannot attend the conference in person, we also accept abstracts for virtual presentation and publication of paper in our journals. After your abstract and full paper is accepted, you need to send us your PowerPoint presentation with visual recordings. The length of the virtual presentation should also be limited to 15 minutes.


