

2020 International Conference: Bringing together the International Community of Researchers, Academicians and Professionals

TU-PNC, 01 February 2020 – Prithvi Narayan Campus has organized the “2020 International Conference” to be held on 9-10 April 2020 in Pokhara. The conference will be chaired by Dr. Vikash Kumar KC, Professor of Statistics at Prithvi Narayan Campus, Pokhara.



According to the Conference Secretariat, the general theme of the conference is the “Current and Future Directions in Research, Theory and Practice,” and papers will cover multiple disciplines to present the latest research topics related to humanities & social sciences, management & law, education and science & technology.

Responding to our reporter’s question, the Conference Coordinator Dr. Min Pun said that the conference is organized to bring together the international community of researchers, academicians and professionals around the world. The main purpose of the conference is to promote strong connections between research, theory and practice and explore different perspectives on the application of research findings into practice, he added.

Dr. Suresh Raj Sharma, the founder Vice-Chancellor of Kathmandu University and Dr. Tom Robertson, the former Executive Director of the United States Fulbright Commission to Nepal have been invited to deliver keynote speech, the source said.

Participants will be divided into four tracks, namely humanities & social sciences as Track 1, management & law as Track 2, education as Track 3 and science & technology as Track 4. Each track will have a parallel session for two days and upto 25 research papers will be presented in each track.

The deadline for the submission of abstract has been set for 10 February 2020, full paper submission for 29 February and presentation materials submission for 15 March 2020.

In order to run the conference smoothly, the campus has formed the conference organizing committee headed by Dr. Min Pun. The committee consists of Dr. Kapil Adhikari, Dr. Nawa Raj Neupane, Nagendra Bahadur Bhandari and Resam Lal Poudel as its members.

The conference will be supported by the Gandaki Province Government and 19 campuses/colleges under Tribhuvan University and Pokhara University will be as institutional partners for the conference, it is learnt.
